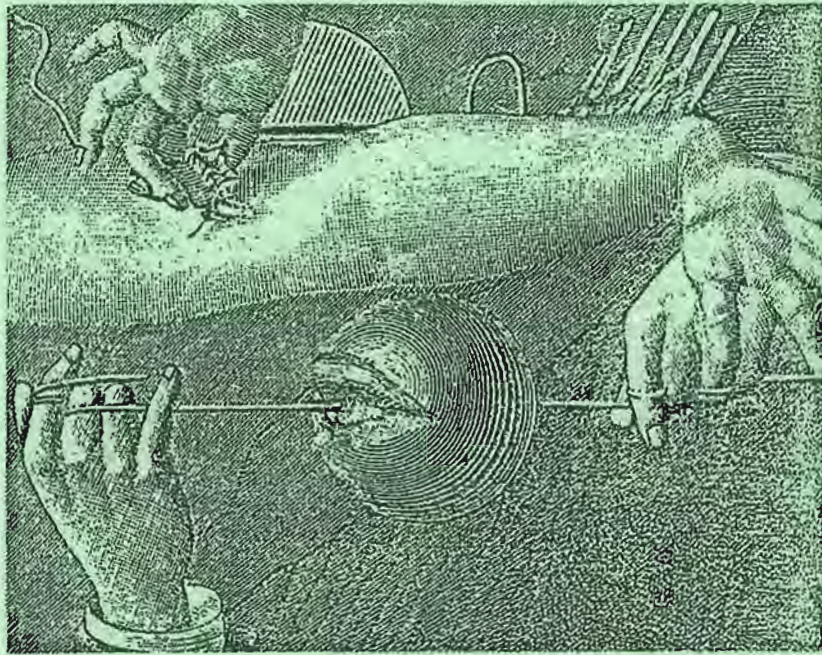

of its own.



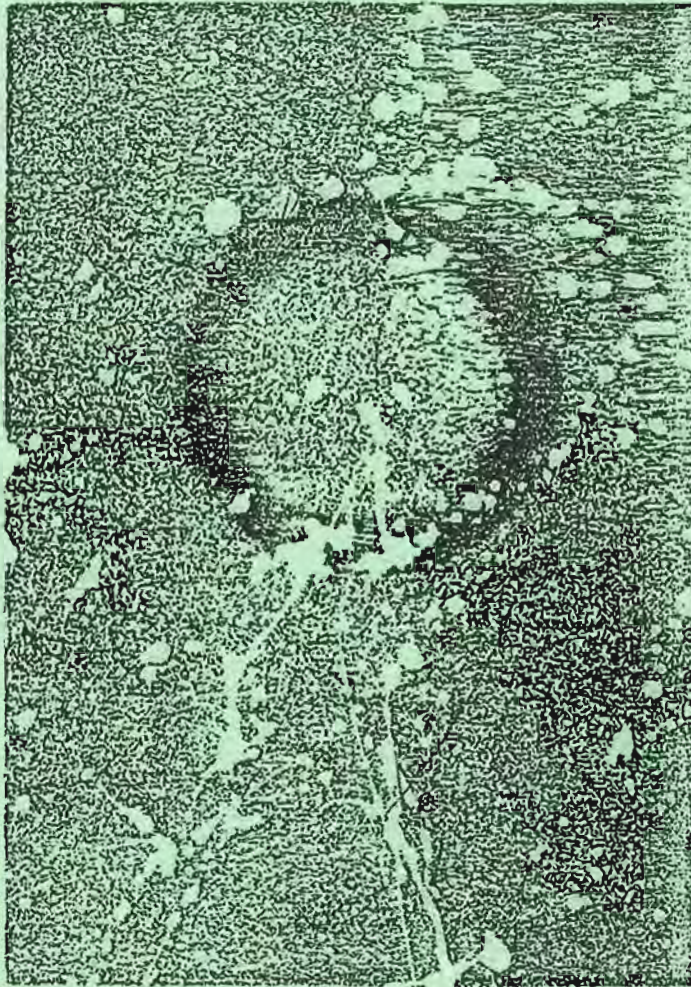
Yoni --
